

## Supplementary sheet for Tor Helness – Geir Helgemo, Norway

### 2H (weak two in hearts or spades)

Standard weak two, no difference between hearts or spades. It's not mandatory to open all hands between 4-10 HCP. It all depends on common sense, suit quality and vulnerability. I.e. no ridiculus openings. If 2H-pass, we have to guess what to do.

#### 2H – X

Pass = P/C  
2S = Spades  
2NT = System on  
3C/D = Nat. NF.  
3H = P/C  
3S = Nat. and forcing  
4H = P/C

#### 2H – 2S

X = Negative  
3H/4H = To play in partners heart suit.  
2NT = System on  
3C/D = Nat. NF.

#### 2H – 3C/D

X = Pen.  
3H = P/C  
3S = Nat. F.  
4C/D = Bid your suit.  
4H/S = To play

#### 2H – P

2S = P/C  
3H = P/C  
4H = P/C

### 2S (5-5 red or blacks, weak two strength).

#### 2S – X

XX = Strong hand, pull if reds.  
Pass = P/C  
2NT = System on  
3/4C/D/H/S = P/C

#### 2S – 3C/D/H/S

X = Negative  
Bids = P/C.
